SATURDAY ARRIVAL, May 27th, 2023.

CHECK IN WITH THE CAMPGROUND AS YOU ENTER. IF YOU HAVE NOT PREPAID YOUR CAMPING FEE, HAVE THE EXACT CASH OR CHECK READY AT THE TIME YOU ARRIVE. THEY WILL DIRECT YOU TO YOUR PARKING SPACE FOR THE WEEKEND, PLEASE REVIEW THE CAMPGROUND RULES AND FOLLOW THEM.

Ride Check-in is open Saturday 05/27/2023 from 9:00 am until dinner at 6:00 pm. Please bring your coggins and rabies papers for horses to registration. All riders must be finished checking and vetting by dark on Saturday. NO CHECK-IN OR VETTING FOR ENDURANCE RIDERS or RIDE AND TIE ON SUNDAY!!!

2:00 pm: Vetting starts. We will vet until dark. All horses must be vetted before dark.

3:00 to 4:00 pm: Please bring your covered dish to share and get a meal ticket. If you will not have a dish to share, you can purchase a meal ticket for \$10.

6:00 pm: Share-A-Dish meal.

7:00 pm: Ride meeting, followed by a new rider meeting

10:00 pm: All generators off for the evening

SUNDAY RIDE, May 28th: Farrier on call Sunday JEFF WALKER 315-794-9400 – must pay farrier at time of service.

5:30 am – 75 mile riders out.

6:30 am – 50 milers out and 30/50 mile Ride-N-Tie out

7:30 am – 30 milers out and 12 mile Ride-N-Tie out

9:30 am – Clinic riders out

1:00 pm - hopefully we have a food truck on site

2:45 pm – all 30 milers finish.

3:30 pm – 30 mile awards/vet cards

6:30 pm – all 50 milers finish.

7:30 pm – 50 mile awards/vet cards

11:30 pm – all 75 milers finish.
