**NATURE OF PETITION OF DISPUTE:** PennDOT stated based on the traffic numbers presented by McMahon for 320 trips per day that additional studies are not required and they accept the study presented to them dated March 2016 as sufficient: We challenge that decision per PennDOT’s Policies and Procedures for Transportation Impact Studies, as related to Highway Occupancy Permits,

- 1) Transportation Impact Study Warrants: The Department requires a TIS for all HOP applications, We challenge the March 2016 study that McMahon performed and we want PennDOT to do a new study. To review three separate issues for the HOP as listed below.

**PURPOSE OF PETITION:**

- 1) Route 737 north of interstate I-78 needs a PennDOT Traffic study. Adding additional traffic volume to the current 2,300 AADT could create unsafe traveling through the newly proposed intersection for Long Lane across from the Warehouse Driveway.
- 2) The driveway/intersection change for Long Lane currently does not require a reduced speed limit nor any traffic signalization. We believe a study is needed to review the curve of the road, line of sight and a reduced speed limit. As well as driveway volume requiring traffic signalization.
- 3) The grade from the proposed driveway/new intersection to the Route 737/Old 22 intersection requires a hazardous grade study for speed limits and non-airbraking due to the Noise Ordinance imposed by Greenwich Township.

- 1) 2015 Berks County Traffic Volume Study performed by PennDOT, AADT (Annual Average Daily Traffic)
- 2) PennDOT Policies and Procedures for Transportation Impact Studies
- 3) PA Code Title 67, Transportation

**The increased traffic trailer traffic is in direct conflict to the Greenwich Township Ordinance 802:**

ARTICLE VIII ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION Section 802 PROHIBITED NUISANCES
